Sixth Annual Radiant Systems Sprint for Cancer Raises more than \$130,000 for Georgia Cancer Foundation

The Radiant Charity Corporation, the nonprofit organization supported by Radiant Systems, Inc. More than 1,600 registered runners participated in the 5K and 10K road race on April 20 at Atlantic Station.
